Menta (or mint liquor)	0,33	10	0,25
Squeeze of Lime			
Mint Leaves			
Club Soda		top	

 **Size:** tall glass

 **Directions:** Muddle mint leaves and lime, add crushed ice and stir other ingredients


 **Garnish - if desired:** sprig of fresh mint
